We at Techionista use cookies. We do this to collect information about pages that are being visited on our website, to track how often users come back, and to see which pages are performing well. We also keep track of what information the browser shares. By clicking on "Agree" you permit us to use cookies. For more information, please read our privacy and cookie statement.

5. What are cookies

A cookie is a small piece of text sent to your browser by a website you visit. It helps the site remember information about your visit, which can make it easier to visit the site again and make the site more useful to you.*

We at Techionista use cookies to improve our website and make our website more user-friendly.

7. Types cookies we use at Techionista

Necessary cookies

The necessary cookies can't be switched off and are mandatory for our website to function properly.

Permanent cookies

Permanent cookies help us to recognize you when you revisit our website. The website can therefore be specially set to your preferences. Even if you have permitted the placement of cookies, we can remember this through a cookie. As a result, you do not have to repeat your preferences every time, so you can save time and make the use of our website more pleasant. You can delete permanent cookies via the settings of your browser.

Analytic cookies

Every time you visit our website a cookie is generated. This cookie indicates whether you have visited our website before. Only on the first visit, a cookie is created. On subsequent visits, the existing cookie is used. We use this cookie for statistical purposes. The following data is collected:

- How often a user visits our website site;
- · Which pages a user views;
- From which page the user leaves the website;
- How long a user stays on a page.

Session cookies

With the help of a session cookie, we can see which parts of the website you have viewed during your visit. This allows us to adapt our service and analyze the surfing behavior of our users. These cookies are automatically deleted when you close your web browser.

Google Analytics

On our website, we use Google Analytics. We use this service to keep track of our visitors' behavior on our website. Google may provide this information to third parties. We do not have any influence on this. We have allowed Google to use the obtained analytics information for other Google services.

Social Media Buttons

On our website, we use social media buttons. These buttons are used to promote or share our website on social media accounts such as Facebook, LinkedIn, and Instagram. These buttons use pieces of codes provided by Facebook/LinkedIn/Instagram, and through this code, cookies are placed. We do not have any influence on this. We refer to the privacy statement of <u>Facebook</u>, <u>LinkedIn</u>, and <u>Instagram</u> for more information.

<u>Unforeseen cookies</u>

We also use YouTube videos and blog posts on our websites. We call this embedded content. Sometimes embedded content uses cookies. We do not have control over these third parties. For more information, go to the privacy statement of <u>Youtube</u>.

8. Do you receive our newsletters?

With permission, Techionista uses your email address, your first and last name to be able to send you one of our newsletters. You can always unsubscribe from our newsletter. Just go to the "unsubscribe" button within the newsletter.

9. Rights with regard to your data

You have the right to request access, correction, or deletion of your personal data. You also have the right to object to the processing of personal data and the right to data portability.*

You can send an email to info@techionista-academy.com with the subject 'Objection to the processing of personal data'. To prevent misuse, we may ask you to identify yourself adequately. Techionista will then respond to your request for inspection or correction within four weeks. In the event of a request for deletion, Techionista will delete the relevant personal data as soon as possible. We will send you a confirmation message after the execution of a request for deletion. If Techionista has not (partially) removed the relevant personal data, Techionista will send the visitor a message in which Techionista will explain why the request could not be (fully) met.
